SUNDAY/FEERUARY SILL

The following sample schedule provides an overview of what to expect at the Acadia Robofest e Championship. Times and details are subject to change, and will be officially released in January, 2026

MORNING

Team Check-In

Teams will receive an information packet for the day, as well as lunch tickets and custom-coloured t-shirts. Teams are shown to their assigned "Pit" table.

First UTF Reveal

Teams receive their Unknown Tasks and Factors (UTF), beginning a 30-minute work period. All adults and non-team members head to the stands while teams adjust their programs and practice on the provided tables.

Impound

All robots will be dropped off to their assigned impound bin following an inspection for height, weight, and sensor restrictions, if applicable.

Round One

Each team competes at an official Game table, followign the pre-released schedule. Teams are prohibited from entering their Pits during the round.

MID-DAY

LUNCH

Teams can enjoy complimentary all-you-care-to-eat lunch at Acadia's Wheelock Dining Hall.

AFTERNOON

Second UTF Reveal

Second 30-minute work period begins. Teams receive different UTFs for the second round than the first.

Impound & Round Two

All robots to impound area and teams to stands for final round of robot Games. Each team will head to the photo booth for a professional group photo following their Game run.

Awards Ceremony

After a brief tally of scores, the top-performing teams are recognized with awards and potential opportunities to advance to the World Championship.
